IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR THE PARENTS FOR SESSION 2023-2024

- 1. Parents have to ensure that their ward reaches school **ten minutes before** the school bell. Late coming to school will not be permitted.
- 2. Students should be **properly dressed** in the prescribed school uniform and well-groomed while coming to school. School reserves the right to send back the student if he/she is improperly dressed or groomed.
- 3. Parents should **check the school almanac daily** to monitor the child's progress in school. Parents should regularly check their ward's school bag to ensure that the child is not carrying any prohibited items to school.
- 4. Parents should always **monitor the child's behavior** and be aware of his/her friends. Discuss with the class teacher if any help required to counsel the child.
- 5. Office visiting hours are **9 am to 11 am**, please avoid other timings for the smooth functioning of the office.
- 6. Parents can meet the concerned teacher on Saturdays after school gets over. The parent can meet the class teacher on other days only in extreme/urgent cases that too after informing in the office.
- 7. Funds are required for the development of any organization. It is the duty of the parent to pay the fee on time. School fee has to be deposited latest by 15th of the fee payable month. It is preferred that the fee is paid online as per CBSE guidelines. If the fee is paid by cheque then please ensure that the pay in slip is properly filled and child's name and SR no. is written at the back of the cheque also. With effect from this session Cheques will be accepted only till 15th of the fee payable month. Late fee of Rs.20 per day will be charged till the end of the fee

- payable month and thereafter the student will not be allowed to attend the classes until readmission is done. All dues must to be paid to be eligible for enrollment to the next class.
- 8. It is preferred that the **tiffin and water bottle be sent along** with the student. There is a lot of waste of time if the tiffin is sent later to school for the student.
- 9. School allows the students of class ninth onwards only to come on their own on bicycles. Students of classes below ninth are not allowed to come on bicycles for their own for safety reasons. Those students who are using bicycles will have to fill up a permission form from the school office.
- 10. Parents to ensure that students of classes XI and XII coming to school by two wheelers have a valid driving license and a helmet.
- 11. School bus facility is optional. Those availing the bus facility please ensure timely payment for regular uninterrupted services.
- 12. Please **ensure that your ward reaches home on time** after the school gets over. It has been noticed that the senior students keep on loitering in the nearby area. School is not responsible for any quarrels taking place between the students after school hours outside the school campus.
- 13. If any student is found **breaking or mishandling the school property** a fine will be imposed and strict action will be taken against the student.
- 14. Please **follow traffic rules** whenever you come to school to drop or pick up your ward. This will help in smooth traffic flow during the school hours. Parents are requested to ensure **proper dress code** while coming to school to maintain the decorum of the school.
- 15. Please **follow proper channel** for any complaints regarding your ward. Class teacher should be contacted immediately. If you are not satisfied then please contact the Academic/Adm coordinators. The teachers and staff are always there to look into your grievances. Please cooperate with them for the betterment of your ward. Always be polite.
- 16. **Discipline is of prime importance in school**, therefore any breach in discipline will be dealt with strictly.
