In Class XII, Parikshit Kumawat secured the top position with an impressive 96%. In Class X too, the students left no stone unturned and brought laurels to the school by achieving a 100% result. The academic year began with Parent Orientation Sessions for each class, where parents were briefed on the curriculum, methodologies, and assessments. These sessions enhanced transparency, strengthened partnerships, and laid the foundation for meaningful learning ahead.

The Prize Distribution Ceremony was held in April to celebrate the hard work and resilience of our students. Awards and certificates were conferred upon deserving achievers, serving as symbols of pride and inspiration for all.

Our students have continued to shine in national-level competitive examinations, reflecting their perseverance and academic excellence.

In 2026, **Rudra Pratap Singh (XII B, Batch 2025-26)** cleared **NDA/ NA-II 2025** written exam as well as his SSB for Air Force in first attempt and has been recommended for 2 AFSB (Mysore) for NDA-156 entry.

In NEET 2025, Rudra Pratap Singh Shekhawat (AIR 15347), Parikshit Kumawat (AIR 29121, OBC 13452), and Vaishnavi Sharma (AIR 142518, EWS 17581) brought laurels to the school with their remarkable results. In JEE Mains 2025, Abhik Khandelwal (99.06 percentile), Jai Mohan Garg (96.88 percentile) and Khyati Shekhawat (94.89 percentile) performed commendably. In the CA Foundation (2023–24 batch), Khushboo Agarwal, Saransh Khandelwal, Pratibha Khandelwal and in the (2024 – 25 batch), Jhanak Sharma and Garima Agarwal achieved success. In CA Intermediate (Batch 2022-23) Akshat Prajapati and Astha Agarwal and (Batch 2023-24) Vidhya Nandwana , Nisha Sadhwani and Khushboo Agarwal achieved success while in the CA Final (2019–20 batch), Aryan Agarwal, Sakshi Agarwal, Tanika Prajapati and Yana Agarwal emerged as qualified Chartered Accountants.

These achievements stand as a testament to the hard work of our students and the dedicated guidance of their mentors.

Bhavya Jain of Class XB proudly secured a spot in the Top 10% of the Indian Olympiad Qualifier in Mathematics.

In **SMUN 2025 at Sanskar School Pranjal Dadhich (XII E)** brought laurel by winning **Special Mention Prize (Mahabharat Committee), Ansh Saxena (IX C), Shivangi Shekhawat (IX C) , Manya Malik (XI A) and Lavanaya Gautam (XI E)** were honoured with **Verbal Mention**.

At **SciPoTech 2024** held at Podar World School on 25th October, our students **Rishima Sharma (IX B) and Bhanu Pratap Singh Rathore (IX A)** brought home 1st Prize for their innovative project, **“Waste Warriors: A Step Ahead Towards Transforming Lives through Science.”** Again, in **2025** our students **Mishika Sharma (VB) and Raghav Upadhaya (VA)** won 1st Prize for their project **‘Step up to sustainability in the Junior Technology Category.’**

In co-scholastic activities, our students showcased creativity, teamwork, and innovation. At **Utsahotsava 2024**, held at **Subodh Public School, Jaipur**, **Navya Natani (X)** and **Sneha Chouhan (X)** achieved the **3rd position** in **Fireless Cooking**, and **Jai Mohan Garg (XII)** along with **Khyati Shekhawat (XII)** won the **2nd position in Code Mania**.

It gives me immense pride to share the outstanding achievements of our students in sports this year.

At the **68th SGFI Karate Tournament**, held from 8th to 12th September 2024 at Mahatma Gandhi Girls School, Banipark, our students showcased remarkable skill and determination. **Navya Walia (X C, U-17 Girls –68 kg)** and **Rashi Tanwar (XII B, U-19 Girls –68 kg)** won silver medals, while **Udhav Vashistha (VI C, U-17 Boys –45 kg)**, **Harnoor Khera (X A, U-17 Girls +68 kg)**, and **Anushka Yadav (XII B, U-19 Girls +68 kg)** secured bronze medals. At the **69th SGFI District Karate Tournament 2025** **Shubham Joshi (VI C, U19 Boys – 35 Kg)** won bronze medal.

At the **68th SGFI Boxing Tournament** at Adarsh Vidya Mandir, Raja Park, **Meet Sirohia (XI D, U-17 Boys –66 kg)** brought home a bronze medal, adding to our proud sporting record.

Our student , **Madhu Choudhary (VI C)** won **3 Gold Medals** at **12th D.L. Invitational Gymnastic Championship 2025** organised by **APSGCAA** and brought laurels to the school

Carrying this spirit forward, our basketball teams made us proud at the **PIE School Olympics 2024**, held at SMS Stadium, Jaipur. The **U-14 Boys' Team** won a silver medal, while the **U-18 Boys' and Girls' Teams** clinched bronze medals. At the **SFA Championship 2024**, the **U-18 Girls' Team** emerged as runners-up, with individual brilliance from **Ansh Saxena** and **Kanishka Rathore**, who won bronze medals in 100m running and Carrom respectively.

Adding to these victories, Rainbow School students have also represented us at the state level. **Vivaan Sharma (XI E)** competed in the **State Youth Open U-17 Basketball Tournament at Udaipur in October 2024**, and in 2025, **Aaradhya Mathur (Batch 2024–25)** carried our banner high at the **U- 23 State Basketball Championship at Deogarh, Rajsamand**. **Ranvijay Singh Shekhawat (VIII A)** and **Garvita Maan (VIII A)** were selected for the **SGFI**

State level U-14 Basketball Tournament and proudly represented Jaipur District. **Garvita Maan (VIII A, U-14 Girls Basketball Tournament)** won second position in 69th SGFI State Level Games representing Jaipur district.

Daksh Rathore (VII C) has been selected in U-14 category for **Netball State Championship**.

This year also saw an extraordinary performance at the **Inter-School Open State Karate Championship 2025** at Vardhaman Sri Kalyan International School, Hathoj. Our young champion **Pari Yadav (IV A, 8-year Girls)** won gold, while **Vedika Rajawat (Prep, 4-year Girls)**, **Nishant Yadav (III A, 5-year Boys)**, and **Udhav Vashistha (VII C, 12-year Boys)** bagged silver. Bronze medals were proudly secured by **Kanika Vadar (IV A, 8-year Girls)**, **Shreyansh Singh (IV, 7-year Boys)**, **Naksh Raj (VI C, 11-year Boys)**, and **Shubham Joshi (VI C, 11-year Boys)**. At **20th CL Jaipuria Memorial Tournament (10th – 12th November 2025)** held by **Dharav High School**, our volleyball U-19 Boys Team secured second position and **Himanshu Kalnaik (XI D)** won Best Attacker's Trophy. These victories shine as proof of discipline, perseverance, and true sportsmanship.

Moving from the playing field to the creative arena, our students also made their mark in interschool competitions. At the **Mosaic Art Competition 2025**, hosted by Sanskar School on 26th April, our talented artists **Gargi Singh (IX)** and **Kashish Sharma (IX)** secured **1st prize in Painting**.

At **C'est Ton Moment**, hosted by Cambridge Court World School, creativity and innovation were at their peak. **Mishika Sharma** earned the **2nd prize in Artistic Horizons**, our **Class XII team** bagged **3rd prize in the Future Forward business pitch**, and our **culinary masters** won **3rd prize in Culinary Arts**.

At the **Vardhman Srikalyan International School Fest**, excellence once again defined Rainbow. Students won **2nd prize in Waste Material to Eco-Friendly Installation**, **3rd prize in Shloka Recitation**, while the **U-19 Basketball Team** finished as **first runners-up**.
